Strategic Initiatives

Administrative Update

- Mark Kring submitted his resignation from the board.
- Patti Jacobson, Admissions Director, is creating a visibility, marketing, communication plan for the school, which will benefit the Foundation as well. We have met several times in the last month.
- Donors and sponsors for the Athletic Boosters' Golf Outing have been thanked; Pam Campbell will send out thank you letters to the 5K donors & sponsors.
- I was quoted in the October issue FundRaiser Journal about Lansing Christian's use of FRP, our donor data base.
- FYI – in case anyone asks why we are not accredited by the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability (ECFA is an accreditation agency for Christian ministries) ... The Foundation meets the ECFA reporting/transparency standards, but given that the Foundation has a full audit annually and that fiscal management is reviewed as part of the NCA/CSI accreditation, creating an additional review process seems unnecessary.
- The funds for the Bowden Endowment for Spiritual Enrichment will be transferred to the Barnabas Foundation this month, with 25% going into the new LCSF Bowden Endowment Balanced Fund immediately and the rest transferred in over the next several quarters.
